



Visitor information

- **Wear closed toe walking shoes; no heels. You will be touring industrial facilities**
- **Dress for the weather; hard hats will be provided for all visitors to wear while touring**
- **No cell phones, i-pods, pagers, etc. Cell phone service is limited at some field sites**
- **No smoking, eating or drinking while touring**
- **Chaperones are required for youth tours and will be expected to assist tour guides as needed**
- **You will be separated from your bus/vehicles while touring; restroom stops will be limited**
- **Walking tours of wastewater treatment plants take 1-2 hours, be prepared**
- **Make sure to have any necessary medications, emergency supplies, inhalers, etc. with you**
- **48 hour cancellation notice is requested**
- **King County staff can end a tour early for any reason. Safety is our first priority.**
