



**W**ork on the Henderson / MLK Way CSO Project will continue on South Norfolk Street this summer. This King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the Rainier Beach community.

### **Upcoming sewer work on South Norfolk Street**

Over the next month, a new 72-inch sewer line will be installed in segments in an open trench west from I-5 through the north parking lot of the Martin Smith building at 3701 S. Norfolk.

King County's contractor will work individually with tenants of the Martin Smith building, including Tel West Communications, Front Porch Classics, Masins, MacDonald Miller to provide access to shipping and receiving bays and coordinate parking during this work.



When work is completed on the Martin Smith property, installation of the pipeline will continue in the public right-of-away along the north side of S. Norfolk St. This phase of work will extend from 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue South east about 300 feet to the south driveway of Nelson Trucking Company.

Construction activities will consist of:

#### **June 2003**

- Gas line relocation, utility locating and installation of dewatering wells in the north parking lot of the Martin Smith building.

#### **July 2003**

- Installation of the 72-inch diameter sewer pipeline in an open trench through the Martin Smith parking lot to 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and S. Norfolk Street.

The excavation will be back-filled as pipe installation progresses in order to restore parking as soon as possible. When pipe installation is complete, final paving and restoration will take place.

#### **August 2003**

- Installation of the 72-inch sewer pipeline in the public right of way from along S. Norfolk and 40<sup>th</sup> Ave S to the Nelson driveway.
- Final paving and restoration of S. Norfolk St.



#### **Traffic Revisions**

S. Norfolk St. and 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. will remain open throughout the pipe installation. Flaggers and signage will direct motorists around work in progress.

#### **What to expect during construction this winter**

In addition to re-routing traffic away from ongoing work, construction impacts at times may include noise, dust and vibration. King County and the contractor are taking steps to minimize any disturbances to community members.
