**W**ork on the Henderson / ML

King CSO Project is ongoing in several parts of Rainier Beach community this winter. This King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the neighborhood.



## Final street paving on S. Henderson St.

Final asphalt street paving on South Henderson Street between Renton Avenue South and 50th Avenue South is scheduled for Tuesday, February 3rd. This work is dependent on weather conditions.

Asphalt street paving will also occur at the King County Henderson Pump Station across from Rainier Beach High School on South Henderson Street at Seward Park Avenue South on February 3rd.

As the street paving progresses between Renton Avenue and 50th Avenue, it will be necessary for crews to close sidewalks and driveways for a few hours in front of immediate areas of work.

Driveway and sidewalk concrete paving, now underway on South Henderson, is scheduled to be complete when street paving begins on February 3rd.



## What to expect during street paving

King County and the contractor are taking steps to minimize any disturbances to businesses and the community.

Construction crews will provide a work schedule to residents and businesses about length of driveway and sidewalk closures in front of their properties.

Lane closures on Henderson will be set in place, and flaggers will direct motorists and pedestrians around the work.

When paving is complete, lane closures on Henderson will be lifted.
