Work on the Henderson / ML

King CSO Project is continuing in several parts of the Rainier Beach community this spring and summer, but most activities along South Henderson Street are now completed.

This important King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the neighborhood.



Care of new grass parking strip on South Henderson Street

New grass has been installed along the south side of South Henderson Street from Rainier Avenue South to Renton Avenue South.

King County's contractor has been maintaining the lawn since March, but under King County's contract, their final mowing will occur the week of April 26th.

At this time, care of the grass parking strip will become the responsibility of the property owner, as it is throughout the City of Seattle.
