Work on the Henderson / ML

King CSO Project is continuing in several parts of Rainier Beach community this spring. This King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the neighborhood.

Manhole work on South Henderson Street



The week of June 14th, King County crews will install a protective liner inside the underground junction manhole on the south side of South Henderson Street between 46th Avenue South and 48th Avenue South. The liner will reduce corrosion in the manhole.

What to expect this work

Traffic will be routed around the work, and flaggers will direct motorists and pedestrians as needed.

go in and out of the
underground manhole
on Henderson Street.***

activities.***

***Work is expected to take about five
working days.***
