# HENDERSON / ML KING CSO PROJECT

**W**ork on the Henderson / ML

King CSO Project is continuing in several parts of Rainier Beach community this Spring. This King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the neighborhood.

## **Sewer line replacement on 42nd Ave. S.**

Tuesday, June 1st, King County crews will begin installation of a sewer line on 42nd Avenue South at the juncture of South Henderson Street and Carkeek Drive South. The sewer line work will proceed north to the top of the hill towards South Trenton Street.



The new sewer line will be installed approximately 5 to 10 feet underground. It will provide a shallow connection alternative to the existing 1920's sewer line that was tunneled 60 feet below ground.

When the new sewer line installation is complete, the trench will be backfilled and 42nd Ave. S. will be paved. Work is expected to take about three weeks.

## **What to expect during this work**

Street parking along 42nd Avenue South will be limited during this work.



As needed, crews will work with residents individually to provide access. Henderson Street will be closed for short periods to both motorists and pedestrians. Neighbors will be asked to use South Trenton Street as an alternate route. Flaggers and signage will direct traffic as well.

Beginning June 1st, Seattle Public School buses will be rerouted from Carkeek Drive S. to S. Trenton St. until school is out on June 17th. Families on 42nd Ave. S. will be informed by Seattle Public Schools about specific routes changes.
