Work on the Henderson / ML

King CSO Project is continuing in several parts of Rainier Beach community this summer. This King County project will help to eliminate overflows to Lake Washington and improve the sewer system throughout the neighborhood.

Curb replacements at Rainier Beach High School


Beginning Wednesday, June 23rd, crews will begin work to replace sidewalk curbs at the corner of South Henderson Street and Seward Park Avenue South in front of Rainier Beach High School.



Work includes installation of new accessible sidewalk ramps at the corner of South Henderson and Seward Park Ave. S., and is scheduled to be completed by Thursday, July 1, 2004.

What to expect during this work

Southbound traffic on Seward Park Ave. S. will be reduced to one lane north of Henderson Street for about one block. The high school parking lot on Seward will be accessible, but street parking will not be permitted along the west side of Seward during this work.



Westbound traffic will also be reduced to one lane on South Henderson for about one block from Seward Park Ave. S. Traffic and buses will be routed around the work, and flaggers will direct motorists and pedestrians as needed.
