



**W**ork on the Henderson / ML King CSO Project is getting underway in your neighborhood. This King County project will help protect public health and the environment by eliminating overflows to Lake Washington and improving the sewer system throughout the Rainier Beach Community.

### **Sewer work on Norfolk Street this spring and summer**

King County will begin sewer work on South Norfolk Street this spring between East Marginal Way South and Airport Way South. Work will continue through the summer.

King County's contractor, Tri-State Construction Inc., will work individually with local businesses to maintain access to properties and emergency services.

Specific construction activities will take place on South Norfolk during the next several months:

- **March 24 to May 15 - Construction of the Duwamish Junction Manhole Structure at Norfolk and East Marginal Way South**

*During this period, Norfolk Street will be closed to through traffic for a six weeks. Local access to businesses will be provided.*

- **April 15 to Aug. 15 – Sewer line construction on South Norfolk Street**  
*Installation of a 72-inch pipeline will take place on Norfolk Street from East Marginal Way South east to Airport Way South. The street should open to through traffic during*

*most of this period. Near the pipeline operation, traffic will be routed around construction.*

- **Aug. 15 to Sept. 15 - Final paving of South Norfolk Street.**

*During this period, some short-term traffic restrictions, such as partial lane closures, may occur.*



### **Traffic revisions**

During this work, road revisions are required to maintain safety and accommodate construction. At times, public use will be limited or delayed by the work. Signs and flaggers will direct traffic as needed and ensure public safety.

### **What to expect during construction**

Besides rerouting traffic away from ongoing work, construction at times could include noise, dust and vibration. King County and the contractor are taking steps to minimize any disturbances to businesses.
