



Project Update - August 22, 2008

King County's contractor will erect security fencing around the construction site as early as today, August 22, 2008. Public access to the area immediately north and south of the Denny Way Regulator in Myrtle Edwards Park will be restricted until the project's completion in late fall 2008.

Park users will continue to have access to both the bicycle and pedestrian trails throughout the project. Construction equipment may temporarily obstruct the pedestrian walkway along the shoreline as it enters the site. Truck traffic to and from the work site will be present at times on the access road/bike path along the park's eastern border. Bicyclists and pedestrians will have to share the western asphalt pathway when trucks are present. Traffic control personnel will direct traffic and enforce detours when trucks pass through the park.

King County urges park users to remain alert and cautious near the work site.

Work will typically occur between 7:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Monday - Saturday. To complete the project prior to the winter wet season, King County's contractor may work seven days a week and/or around the clock during certain phases of the project.

This project is part of King County's ongoing effort to reduce combined sewer overflows into Elliott Bay. Repairing damaged equipment and improving the facility's hydraulics will prevent further damage to the facility and reduce the chance of overflows into the park during storms.


