CONSTRUCTION WORK ON BEACH DRIVE

February 27, 2006


A King County contractor is repairing a 30-inch sewer line in Lincoln Park after wastewater workers discovered a sewage leaks on January 17th and February 4th.

To complete the emergency repairs King County's contractor will be constructing an underground structure on Beach Drive Southwest in front of 7161 Beach Drive SW.

The work should take approximately two weeks and start on March 3rd. During this time there will be no access south of 7161 Beach Drive SW and limited access local access to the rest of Beach Drive SW south of Lowman Park.

In addition to limiting access, there will be an increase in traffic along Beach Drive SW, as well as noise related to construction during the day. Access to Beach Drive SW will be restored in the evening after each workday is completed.
