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## ***Construction underway at York Pump Station on Standby Generator Project***


Construction of three standby generators at York Pump Station began in early March. The generators will enhance safety and reliability by insuring a backup power source in the event of a power outage.

### ***Project schedule***

Construction will be visible on site from March 2005 until the project is completed by early 2006.

### ***What you can expect***

- Construction will occur on King County property.
- The contractor will restore all area to as good or better condition after the construction is complete.
- J.B. Instant Lawn operates next to the construction area. They are open for business as usual. We appreciate their cooperation in coordinating parking and other logistics. We hope the construction does not inconvenience any of their customers. Impacts to other businesses in the area are expected to be minimal.
- All work will be done as safely and quickly as possible.



*York Pump Station, at 14120 NE 124<sup>th</sup> Street in Redmond, was built in 1992. It handles about 10 million gallons per day of wastewater. The York Pump Station receives wastewater from the 72-inch diameter Northeast Lake Sammamish interceptor. Wastewater flow is pumped through two force mains (30- and 48-inch diameter) to the north end of the Eastside interceptor and then to the treatment plant in Renton. The service area includes northern Pine Lake Plateau, Lake Hills and Redmond.*
